Goals:

This course aims to train national judges on recent case law of the Court of Justice on Articles 101 and 102 TFEU and to share information concerning the national developments under the Private Enforcement Directive (2014/104/UE), providing national judges with intensive and in-depth training on these issues through lectures, workshops and conferences.

Plenary sessions and workshops to be lectured in Portuguese and English Final conference in English.
