- 5. Personal data provided by you will be made available to entities which have the right to obtain it pursuant to the applicable laws or under a contract, in particular:
- delegated employees and persons,
- entities providing KSSiP with IT services,
- entities providing KSSiP with mail and courier services.
- 6. Your personal data will be stored for a period necessary to provide responses to communications and for a period envisaged in the applicable laws governing the storage of specific documents. Moreover, your data may be stored for the purposes of or the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims filed against the Data Controller and resulting from the management of documents received for a period envisaged in the applicable laws.
