CivilLink Training Cycle Description

The *CivilLink* project offers a structured, blended learning path for European judges, combining digital and in-person training to enhance cross-border cooperation in civil matters using e-CODEX and the Recast Regulations (EU) 2020/1783 and 2020/1784.

The **training cycle** includes:

- **Short video tutorials** for introductory familiarisation with the e-CODEX system.
- **Interactive webinars** for conceptual grounding and practical understanding.
- **In-person transnational seminars** for practical, case-based exercises and simulations.
- **Reflective podcasts** for post-training consolidation of key concepts.
- A **final conference** to share experiences and project results at European level

Tutorials – September 2025

Three short video tutorials will:

- Be developed in the upcoming months and will be available online starting with September 2025;
- Cover e-CODEX functionalities, workflows for service of documents and taking of evidence, and data protection principles.

Pre-training Webinar (8 October 2025)

The half-day online webinar will:

- Introduce the Recast Regulations and their practical relevance.
- Present the e-CODEX system's structure, legal value, and Reference Implementation.
- Demonstrate workflows for Service of Documents (SoD) and Taking of Evidence (ToE).
- Cover data protection and cybersecurity requirements in digital judicial cooperation.
- Provide a preview of the practical seminar and address participant questions.

Transnational Seminar (30–31 October 2025, Bucharest)

The 1.5-day seminar will:

- Apply the Recast Regulations in simulated cross-border civil cases.
- Provide hands-on training using e-CODEX for SoD and ToE procedures.
- Discuss practical challenges and troubleshooting in digital cooperation.
- Cover GDPR compliance and data protection responsibilities.
- Facilitate cross-border peer learning and professional networking with EU judges.

Who Can Apply?

- **Civil judges with experience in cross-border civil or commercial proceedings.**
- **English language proficiency is required (training will be in English).**
- Participants committed to attending both the webinar and seminar in full.
- Participants willing to contribute to the project's reflective learning podcasts by sharing their experience and feedback after the seminar.
- Participants motivated to apply the knowledge and share it further within the judiciary.

Gender balance, jurisdictional diversity, and geographical diversity will be pursued during selection.

Through this cycle, judges will:

- Strengthen their practical skills for implementing EU cross-border judicial procedures digitally.
- Gain confidence in using e-CODEX in light of its mandatory implementation starting with 2025.
- Enhance understanding of the Recast Regulations' impact on civil judicial cooperation.
- Develop networks with EU colleagues, supporting a uniform application of EU law.
- Receive a certificate of participation upon completing the full cycle.

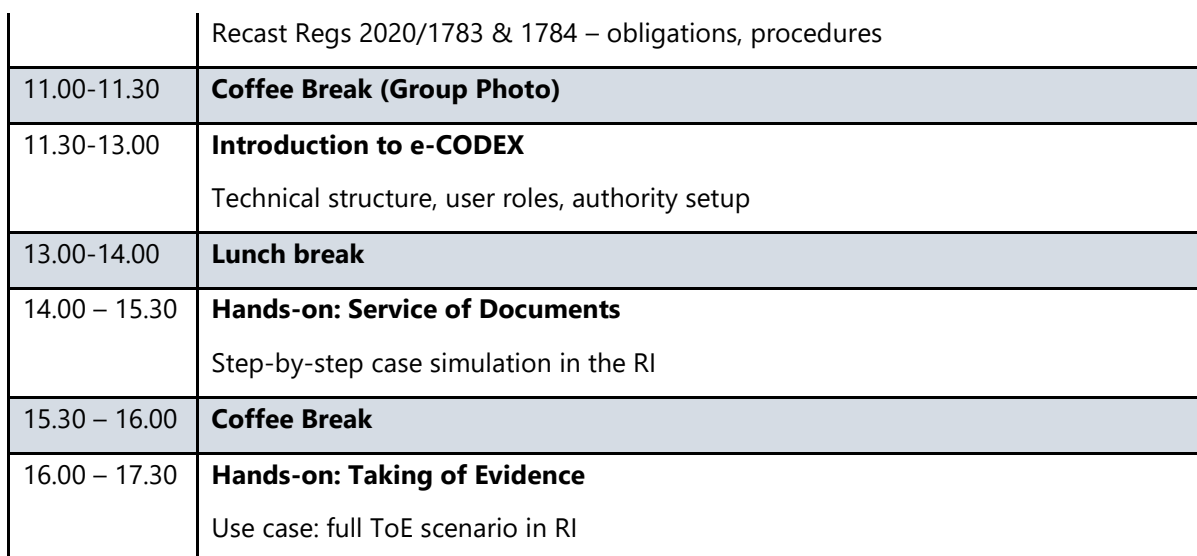
